La Mine Témoin

Museum

Art work of single mine in France, Ales Mine indicator of 1945-1968 was a training center where several apprentices minor successive generations to learn their future profession. Galleries open to the public since 1985, were carved by young people, aged from 14 to 18.

Exceptional testimony of the mining history of the basin of the Cevennes, the Mine indicator Ales today wants a unique memory social and industrial visitable in France. Beneath the hill Montaud - where there were traces of the oldest coal mining in the region (XIII century) - overlooking the site of the old tile Rochebelle site and adjacent to the heap, it this in situ nearly two centuries of technological change on 650m mining galleries.

To discover or rediscover visitors mine, its people and its history but also to answer questions about the present and the future of this energy was the Mine indicator Ales aims and what will be the coal .

Its role is to convey to the young people a true picture of the world of mine and get them to understand the work and lives of his men and their families who have strongly influenced the history of Alès basin.

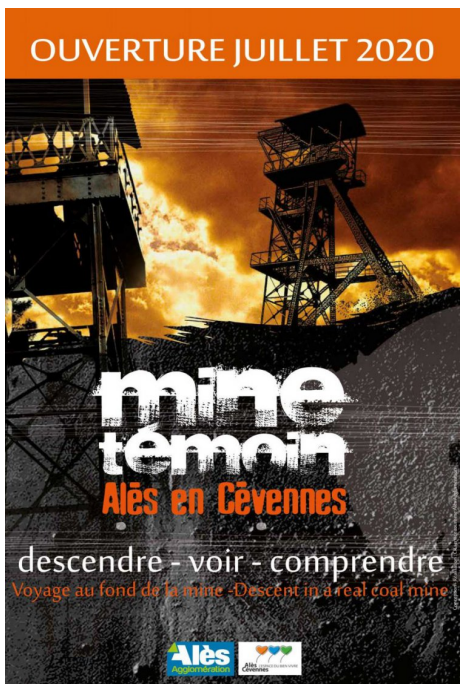

House Miner offers an exceptional overview of surface installations of coal production in the Cévennes, an overview of the work of the miner through objects and stories, a moving discovery of the heritage and history of the mining basin of the Grand combe.

Reservations for groups, possibility to visit accompanied by former employees of Collieries.

La Maison du Mineur à la Grand Combe en Cévennes

1800 paniers, 180 Douches

La visite commence d'abord par le bâtiment des lavabos où se douchaient les mineurs à chaque sortie de poste de travail. On y comptait 1800 paniers hissés au plafond au moyen d'une chaîne. Un panier numéroté était attribué à chaque mineur lors de son affectation à la mine. Dans ce panier, celui-ci y rangeait ses vêtements. Le lavabo est maintenant une salle de collections où l'on trouve les photos, lampes, matériels de fond, briquettes et boulets de charbon, fossiles, plans ainsi que la reconstitution de l'habitat du mineur au début du siècle. L'atelier de lampes de mine de sûreté dans son état d'origine (1873) vaut vraiment le coup d'oeil ! Ici, on touche du doigt le quotidien du mineur. Rien n'est factice. Tout est d'époque sauvé in extremis de l'oubli....

Le Carreau Ricard

La visite se poursuit sur l'ancien carreau vers la salle des machines. Le chevalement du Puits Ricard est à lui seul très impressionnant. Il permettait la descente des cages jusqu'à 801 mètres de profondeur. Ce Puits comme l'ensemble du site a été construit entre 1932 et 1935 et fermé en 1978. Il est classé Monument Historique et a fait l'objet d'un important chantier de restauration en 2010 qui permet maintenant la visite des abords du Puits avec une signalétique extérieure très pédagogique. En entrant dans la salle des machines, depuis une passerelle panoramique, on peut observer le tambour sur lequel s'enroulaient les câbles de la machine d'extraction, unique en Europe. Sont aussi à voir le poste du machiniste, les compresseurs d'air, les génératrices d'électricité.

Autour du Puits Ricard

Le visiteur découvre l'univers du bâtiment de la Recette, située sous le chevalement. C'est le niveau d'arrêt des cages qui permettait au personnel de rentrer et de sortir de la cage, d'évacuer et de charger le matériel et les berlines. Enfin sur la gauche, avant le retour vers les lavabos, le visiteur longe les ateliers spécialisés où étaient réparés tout ce qui concernait les outils et le matériel du carreau Ricard.

La Maison du Mineur offre donc une vue d'ensemble exceptionnelle des installations de surface de la production houillère en Cévennes.

La maison du mineur propose un panorama du travail du mineur à travers objets et témoignages.

Une découverte émouvante du patrimoine et de l'histoire du bassin minier de La Grand combe.

In the heart of a typical hamlet in the Cevennes, the alleyways lead to the birthplace and house of Camisard leader, Roland. Through artifacts and authentic documents, **the DESERT MUSEUM** brings to life the **Huguenot past and the history of the Camisards**.

Why the Desert ?

In the history of French Protestantism, the expression *Desert* defines the period of time between the Revocation of the [Edict of Nantes](#) (1685) and the French Revolution (1789).

Deprived of freedom of worship, far from the cities, hidden in isolated areas, deserts (in the wilderness, forests, caves, or gullies...), where the Protestants in France (in the Cevennes, but also in Haut-Languedoc, in Poitou, Dauphiné, Vivarais...) were obligated to live out their faith in hiding.

The Assembly of the Desert

This is a large gathering Protestant organized every year on the first Sunday in September on the grounds of the Museum of the Desert.

The first meeting took place September 24, 1911, at the inauguration of the Museum with its founding. Since then, every year except for a few years of war, takes place the meeting of the Desert, involving 15,000 to 20,000 people in an atmosphere that is both recovered and happily family.
